### ACCESS TO INFORMATION - Local Government (Democracy) (Wales) Act 2013 Section 55

Places statutory duties on local authorities to make certain information available electronically with a regularly updated website providing the public with the ability to access the information as detailed below.

The Act requires Community Councils to have websites which are to contain the following:-

- to publish notices and papers electronically
- to publish their register of members interests electronically
- information how to contact the clerk
- list of Council's members, contact details, party affiliation (if any) and any office or committee held within the Council. If the community is divided into community wards the ward for each member represents must be shown
- whether the council member has been co-opted or elected
- minutes of the meetings
- annual audited accounts

Councils can operate their own independent website or link up with other Community Councils in the their area or the Principal Council or independent body that will host their site
