26 Feb	<p>Police Report</p> <p><u>Community Speedwatch</u></p> <p>A number of members highlighted that they would like to support the police by getting the community speed watch scheme up and running again in their areas. Concerns around carry out checks in your own wards was discussed but a number of members felt that if they carried out checks in a neighbouring community and vice versa this would resolve that issue. John Morris who is now confirmed in post as community speed watch coordinator is happy to conduct new training sessions at the request of community members. He has advised that a community speed watch needs a minimum of 4 members and requires one person to be the lead co-ordinator. Once trained a camera can be purchased and Go Safe will fund hi vis jackets and signs. Since the meeting it has also been agreed that PC 3164 Dan Jones will act as CPW SPC in the WR area and be on hand to conduct checks with groups to allow confidence in the process.</p> <p>If you wish to set up a community speed watch John can be contacted by email at John.Morris@nthwales.pnn.police.uk</p>
